1. 100 Barclay St.

There's no need to venture outside for a fine glass of riesling thanks to 100 Barelay St.'s exclusive wine-tasting room. With climate-controlled lockers that each hold more than 100 bottles, this Tribeca structure brings home the ideal epicurean experience. The residence also neighbors renowned winery New York Vintners, which provides an array of sommelier services for all wine enthusiasts. 2. 180 E. 88th St.

This Carnegie Hill condominium possesses numerous luxurious amenities, including a temperature-controlled wine cellar with private wine cabinet storage. The cellar's sleek, spacious design and arched architecture make it the perfect location for group wine tastings. 3. Brooklyn Point
